Covid Update:

Mulberry Academy Shoreditch will be closed to ALL students from the 4th – 8th January 2021. Students in Year 11 and 13 will be taught via live lessons on Microsoft Teams from Tuesday 5th January. All other students should follow their usual timetables, sign in to ALL lessons and complete the work set and/or if the lesson is being taught live to attend it.

Monday 4th January is a Staff Inset Day and no lessons will be happening on this day.

Public Examinations

Students who have BTEC Exams on Wednesday 6th and Friday 8th January are to attend those exams as normal. The school will be open for those BTEC students ONLY who have exams on those days.
