Year 11 and 13

All students in **Year 11 and Year 13** will receive live lessons following virtually their in-school timetable. The teacher, in most cases, will deliver the lesson live, this means they will give a live video for parts of the lesson with chat available throughout for questions. Students can upload work they complete for teachers to mark key pieces. Teachers will be taking a register so it is vital they arrive on-time to the virtual lesson.

Students in Year 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12

Students will be set work for all their subject areas, this can be found on the Microsoft Team page for their class. Students should go to their Teams lessons and follow the school timetable virtually. Many lessons will be delivered live, this means they will give a live video for parts of the lesson with chat available throughout for questions. Students can upload work they complete for teachers to mark key pieces. Teachers will be taking a register so it is vital they arrive on-time to the virtual lesson.
