Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that I have decided to send Year 13 students on their Flexible Revision Timetable as from today, Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May. This decision has been made in order to allow students time to study at home in preparation for any remaining exams they have over the coming weeks.

As you are probably aware we do not send students in any year group on significant periods of early study leave, but we have reached the stage this half term where the majority of lessons that Year 13 take, are lessons where exams are taking place, or where exams have already been taken. I would refer you to the exam timetable for your child, which they have been given, but which is also available on our website, to ensure that your child attends for exams on the correct days and at the correct time.

Can I reiterate that Year 13 have had several occasions as a year group where their exam timetable has been given to them and this has been thoroughly talked through with them and that they are fully aware of when their exams are and what they have to bring for each exam. A list of exam warm-up sessions will be posted on Teams.

May I remind you that your child must accept a firm and backup choice on UCAS by **Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> June**.

The Year 13 celebratory leaving dinner will be on **Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June from 5:00pm – 8:00pm**. This is by invitation only and invitations will be sent in the coming days. We would like all invited and attending students to dress smartly.

The final date that is very important for your child is **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> August 2022** when they will need to come in to the school to collect their A Level and BTEC exam results **between 8am and 12pm** at the school.
