

# Year 7 get creative at Greenwich University

On Wednesday a group of Year 7 students went on a trip to Greenwich University's Medway Campus in Kent. They were given a tour of the university and a £5 voucher to buy their own lunch in the cafe there. They participated in a project, sponsored by Dell, aimed at creating new technology to tackle world issues. Working in groups, they had to assign roles such as project manager, sales and marketing and present PowerPoints on their chosen projects which were about Climate Change and Disability. They had a really exciting day and developed their team work skills, problem-solving skills, confidence and creativity.



## Year 12 Mock Trial

Last week, Year 12 students studying Criminology took part in a mock Crown Court trial in a 'Crime Scene to Courtroom' workshop run by the University of Derby to help them understand the roles of legal bodies and professionals within a courtroom. After spending time analysing the case, the courtroom was replicated in the classroom with a judge, jury, prosecution Lawyer, defence Lawyer and all the professionals that would be involved in a real case. It was a great way for students to develop a knowledge and understanding of the role of law and the justice system in our society and gain an insight into the legal process.
