| Computer science | Once a half term     | Set by the teacher. This will be assigned in the first lesson and due back in the final lesson of that half term.   |
| Drama            | Once a half term     | Set by the teacher. This will be context research.  |
| English          | Once a week          | Either reinforcement or application of in-class learning, or flipped learning.  |
| French           | Every week           | Set by the teacher. Homework booklet.   |
| Geography        | Once every two weeks | Set by the teacher. Either Posters, Map/sketch map work, Factfiles, or Reading comprehension.   |
| History          | Every week           | Set by the teacher. Consolidating and developing work from lesson or widening the lens of the topic eg 'meanwhile, elsewhere' research  |
| Food technology  | Once every two weeks | Set by the teacher. Based on given topics e.g. Hygiene and safety in the kitchen; nutrition, evaluating dishes / products made etc.   |
| Latin            | Once every two weeks | Set by the teacher.   |
| Maths            | Every week           | On www.sparxmaths.uk. Students need to create an account using their full name and date of birth. Homework will then be automatically set and marked.   |
| Music            | Three per half term  | Set by the teacher. Music theory quizzes on Teams. This will follow and support learning in class. Topics include: Reading rhythm, identifying pitches, time signatures and musical elements. |
| RE               | Twice a half term    | Set by the teacher.   |
