## RE: Homework and home learning

Homework and home learning is vital to ensure students are consolidating learning from lessons or preparing for future topics. In order to help you support your child succeed to with their homework, we have created the table below.

Subject	Frequency	Home Learning Instructions and Information
Art	Twice a half term	Set by the teacher, instructions will be on MS Teams. Practice key skills, artist research or planning for final outcome
Computer Science	Once a half term	Set by the teacher. This will be assigned in the first lesson and due back in the final lesson of that half term.
Drama	Once a week	Set by the teacher. This will be context research.
English	Once a week	Either reinforcement or application of in-class learning, or flipped learning.
French	One every two weeks	Set by the teacher. Homework booklet.
Geography	Once a week	Set by the teacher. Either Posters, Map/sketch map work, Factfiles, or Reading comprehension
History	Once a week	Set by the teacher. Consolidating and developing work from lesson or widening the lens of the topic eg 'meanwhile, elsewhere' research
Food Technology	Once every two weeks	Set by the teacher. Based on given topics e.g. Hygiene and safety in the kitchen; nutrition, evaluating dishes / products made etc.
Latin	Once every two weeks	Set by the teacher.
Maths	Once a week	On <a href="http://www.sparxmaths.uk">www.sparxmaths.uk</a> . Students need to create an account using their full name and date of birth. Homework will then be automatically set and marked.
Music	Once every two weeks	Set by the teacher. Music theory quizzes on Teams. This will follow and support learning in class. Topics include: Reading rhythm, identifying pitches, time signatures and musical elements.
RE	Twice a half term	Set by the teacher.
Science	Once a week	Set on <a href="https://senecalearning.com">https://senecalearning.com</a> . Students have been shown how to log on in class.
Spanish	Once a week	Set by the teacher. Homework booklet.

Students will be expected to write down what their homework is and when it is due in their planners.
