Dear parent/carer,

If you believe your child is eligible for Free School Meals, we require evidence to support this.

This can consist of the following:

A letter dated within the last 12 months from the Local Authority confirming eligibility for free school meals. You can request this from the benefits office.

Or

Evidence which meets the eligibility criteria:

In order to have access to Free School Meals you must be receiving a benefit below:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- National Asylum Seekers Support
- Guarantee Element of Pension Support
- Child Tax Credit with No element of Working Tax Credit, and a household income below £16,190 (as assessed by HMRC)
- Universal Credit with net earnings not exceeding £7,400pa

You can email it to FSM@mulberryacademyshoreditch.org or drop it into the main reception and we will keep a copy.

If you are worried that you are not able to retrieve this evidence, please send your child to see Ms Morgan Black.

Please note, we are not able to provide any free school meals for your child after Friday 20th September 2024 without having received this evidence.
