

Homework and home learning is vital to ensure students are consolidating learning from lessons or preparing for future topics. In order to help you support your child succeed with their homework, we have created the table below with information on what homework they will be set by their teacher and some extra work for them to complete if they would like to.

Subject	Frequency	How long should the homework take?	Home Learning Instructions and Information	If students would like to complete more work they can...
Art	Twice a half term	45-60 mins	Set by the teacher on Microsoft Teams. Students will practice key skills, research artists or planning for final outcome.	Research artists and styles on google
Computer Science	Once a half term	60-90 mins	Set by the teacher on Microsoft Teams. This will be assigned in the first lesson and due back in the final lesson of that half term.	Go to https://hourofpython.com/ and complete the tasks
Drama	Once a half term	30-60 mins	Set by the teacher on Microsoft Teams. This will be context research.	Watch a play on YouTube. Ask your teacher for recommendations
English	Once a week	30-60 mins	Set by teacher on Microsoft Teams. Either reinforcement or application of in-class learning, or flipped learning. To be completed on paper.	Read a book and write a book report to give to their teacher
French	Once every week	20-30 mins	Homework booklet handed out at the start of the term. If students lose their homework booklet they need to ask their teacher for a new one. The booklet will also be on Microsoft Teams.	Complete Duolingo every day
Geography	Once a week	30-40 mins	Set by the teacher on Microsoft Teams. Either Posters, Map/sketch map work, Factfiles, or Reading comprehension, news research.	Research on BBC news articles about countries that they are learning about in class
History	Once a week	30 mins	Set by the teacher on Microsoft Teams.	Complete Seneca quizzes on topics they are learning in class
Food Technology	Once every two weeks	30 mins	Set by the teacher on Microsoft Teams. Based on given topics e.g. Hygiene and safety in the kitchen; nutrition, evaluating dishes / products made etc.	Cook a meal at home for their family

Latin	Once every two weeks	20-30 mins	Latin toolkit packs given to students at the start of the half term with homework in. If this is lost students need to ask their teacher for a new one. The Latin toolkit pack can also be found on teams.	Complete quizlets set by Ms Padfield
Maths	Once a week	60 mins	On www.sparxmaths.uk . Students log into their account using their Microsoft Teams account. You will receive an automated email from Sparx prior to the hand in date, and another email to inform of you how your child has done on the homework	Click on the 'XP boost' section on Sparx or click on 'Independent Learning' and choose a topic they want to practice
Music	Once every two weeks	20 mins	Music theory quizzes set on Microsoft Teams. This will follow and support learning in class. Topics include: Reading rhythm, identifying pitches, time signatures and musical elements.	Complete the exercises on www.musictheory.net/exercises
RE	Once every two weeks	30 mins	Set by the teacher on Microsoft Teams	Watch the video series <i>A to Z of Religious Beliefs</i> on Youtube
Science	Once a fortnight	45 mins	Set on https://senecalearning.com . Students have been shown how to log on in class.	Select other courses to complete on Seneca
Spanish	Once every week		Homework booklet handed out at the start of the term. If students lose their homework booklet they need to ask their teacher for a new one. The booklet will also be on Microsoft Teams.	Complete Duolingo every day

Students will be expected to write down what their homework is and when it is due in their planners.
