All homework will be set as an assignment on Microsoft Teams.

Art	Weekly	60 mins	Personal Portfolio targets set weekly in books and on Microsoft Teams.	Research artists and styles on google.
Computer Science	Weekly	30 mins	Homework will be set on SmartRevise/ Gillott Learning weekly. Questions are self-marked and graded. SmartRevise focuses on theory and Gillott Learning on programming.	Go to https://hourofpython.com/ and complete the tasks.
Drama	Weekly	30 mins	Includes log notes and writing, research, section writing, line-learning, script writing, set-text response writing.	Watch a play on Youtube. Ask your teacher for recommendations.
English	Weekly	60 mins	Either reinforcement or application of in-class learning or flipped learning. To be completed on paper.	Complete tasks on Seneca OR read and make notes on PMT notes on all key Literature texts
French	Weekly	60 mins	Homework vocabulary booklet handed out at the start of the term. If students lose their homework booklet, they need to ask their teacher for a new one. The booklet will also be on Microsoft Teams. Languagenut.com tasks to be assigned for online vocab/grammar practice.	Complete practice tasks on Languagenut.com every week.
Geography	Weekly	30 mins	Most weeks' this is tasks on Seneca but can be 8-mark questions or sections from exam papers, online research and comprehension	Research on BBC news articles about countries that they are learning about in class.
History	Weekly	30 mins	Weekly Seneca assignment to consolidate learning or revise previous content.	Complete extra Seneca quizzes on topics they are learning in class.
Hospitality	Weekly	45 mins	Based on given topics e.g. Hygiene and safety in the kitchen; nutrition, evaluating dishes / products made etc.	Cook a meal at home for their family.
Latin	Weekly	60 mins	Latin Knowledge Organisers packs given to students to aid language revision. Students must complete the vocabulary learning sheets provided in lessons as well as translation stories and literature comprehension packs.	Use Duolingo or Quizlet for additional Language Paper practice. Students could also choose a book to read from the Latin and Classics reading list for Papers 2 & 3 practice.



Maths	Weekly	60 mins	On www.sparxmaths.uk. Students log into their account using their Microsoft Teams account. You will receive an automated email from Sparx prior to the hand in date, and another email to inform of you how your child has done on the homework.	Click on the 'XP boost' section on Sparx or click on 'Independent Learning' and choose a topic they want to practise.
Music	Weekly	60 mins	Coursework related research tasks.	Complete the exercises on www.musictheory.net/exercises
PE	Weekly	30 mins	Mock examinations of current component. Work sheets relevant of current component. Parts of their coursework.	Go to BBC Bitesize – GCSE PE, select AQA, and complete the Exam Skills for all topics. Ask your teacher for extra long- answer questions and exam practice.
RE	Weekly	45 mins	Weekly worksheets with revision tasks and exam practice.	Complete courses on Seneca using the topic list on Teams. Look on Teams Enrichment for selected articles and YouTube videos.
Science	Weekly	45 mins for each Science	Set on https://senecalearning.comStudents have been shown how to log on in class.	Select other courses to complete on Seneca.
Spanish	Weekly	60 mins	Homework vocabulary booklet handed out at the start of the term. If students lose their homework booklet, they need to ask their teacher for a new one. The booklet will also be on Microsoft Teams. Languagenut.com tasks to be assigned for online vocab/grammar practice.	Complete practice tasks on Languagenut.com every week.
