PE	Weekly	60 mins	Weekly long answer practice (6-8 marks) Students plan with AO1-AO3, complete in timed conditions and review model answers. One ZigZag page.	See textbook on MS Teams page.
RE	Weekly	60 mins	Weekly worksheets with revision tasks and exam practice.	Complete courses on Seneca using the topic list on Teams. Look on Teams Enrichment for selected articles and YouTube videos.
Science	Weekly	45 mins for each Science	Learning flashcards on carousel and using this memory to complete a quiz (one per science). 3 sets of flashcards and quizzes per week. https://www.carousel-learning.com/	https://www.carousel-learning.com/
